B. 1. Scale of Pay: Pay Band Rs. 15600-39100/- and Grade Pay Rs. 5400/-.

In addition to Pay they will also be eligible for DA, NPA, HRA and Transport Allowance as per rules in force from time to time. At present average minimum monthly emoluments including DA, NPA, HRA and Transport Allowance in Metropolitan Cities is approximately Rs. 49,786/- per month.

- (c) Attested copy of Community Status Certificate in the prescribed form in case of candidates belonging to SC/ST/OBC/PH/Ex.- Serviceman category. - **(b) Centre of Examination:** The written examination and interviews for Delhi, Haryana and Kerala States shall be conducted at Delhi, Gurgaon and Trissur respectively. No request for change of examination centre shall be entertained. However ESIC reserves the right to change the examination centre, if need be.

No TA/DA will be paid to any candidate including SC/ST candidates for appearing in the written test.
